

James Neaton, PhD, is a Professor of Biostatistics in the School of Public Health at the University of Minnesota. Dr. Neaton is also an Adjunct Professor of Medicine, Infectious Diseases and International Medicine in the Department of Medicine at the University of Minnesota. His research interests are in the design, conduct and analysis of clinical trials. Dr. Neaton is Principal Investigator of the Leadership Group for the International Network for Strategic Initiatives in Global HIV Trials (INSIGHT). INSIGHT is funded by the National Institutes of Health (NIH) and conducts large, international HIV treatment trials. Dr. Neaton is a Fellow of the American Statistical Association and the Society for Clinical Trials. He has been recognized by the University of Minnesota with two awards, membership in Academic Health Center Academy for Excellence in Health Research and the Global Engagement Award. Dr. Neaton is a member of the FDA Endocrinologic and Metabolic Drugs Advisory Committee and past member of the Cardiovascular and Renal Drugs Advisory Committee. He has served on many Data and Safety Monitoring Boards for clinical trials sponsored by NIH, the CDC, the U.S. Veterans Administration and the pharmaceutical and medical device industry.
