Dear Vivli Team,

We are contacting you to request clarification regarding the following.

As per your protocol, we will conduct an IPD NMA that will determine the effect size of ADHD medications, as well as potential moderators. In discussions with peers, it became clear that a potential critique by reviewers—based on previously published papers (e.g., <a href="https://pubmed.ncbi.nlm.nih.gov/26608309/">https://pubmed.ncbi.nlm.nih.gov/26608309/</a>)—may question the accuracy of effect sizes due to possible unblinding from medication side effects. For instance, Storebo et al (<a href="https://pubmed.ncbi.nlm.nih.gov/26608309/">https://pubmed.ncbi.nlm.nih.gov/26608309/</a>) assert that it is not possible to fully trust effect sizes in meta-analyses of RCTs because participants may guess the allocation due to side effects. However, this has never been empirically proven.

We would therefore like to use the efficacy and safety data from placebo-controlled stimulant RCTs in children and adults to examine whether the effect sizes (within and between groups) differ between those with and without side effects. Although this analysis was not explicitly stated in our protocol, we consider it necessary to better estimate the accuracy of the conclusions of our main analyses in the portal.

We would greatly appreciate your feedback as to whether this would be an allowable use of the data.

### Dear Dr. Tomlinson,
